It's hard to find the words to fully express our gratitude and gratefulness to you. In 2011, you made it possible for Sixty Feet to hire 11 Ugandan employees, including an in-country Director, nurses, counselors, social workers and administrative staff. Your support enabled

us to purchase three cars that now allow our staff to travel and serve at the various remand homes scattered throughout Uganda. You made it possible for us to launch a child sponsorship

program, allowing us to remove dozens of children and provide them with school fees and basic support that they otherwise would not have. With your support, we're helping fund a new medical clinic and we're partnering to build a library for imprisoned children. And if you can believe it, much, much more.

There's nothing terribly special about the SixtyFeet team here in the US. We're just a bunch of regular families—husbands, wives, businessmen and stay-at-home moms who feel beyond privileged to play a small part in the work God is doing in the country of Uganda. For all that's been accomplished this year, we give all the credit and the glory to our Lord, Jesus Christ, who has truly done more than we could have ever asked or imagined.

The New SixtyFeet Homes!

SixtyFeet is delighted to announce the opening of our own homes—providing room, board, counseling, Biblical truth and copious amounts of love for the children we can remove from the facilities. We are currently in the process of searching for land which we hope to acquire early next year and start construction soon after on a home for the younger children (under 10). Several generous donors have stepped forward to offer a **\$60,000** matching gift that will help fund this major project. Please prayerfully consider donating to SixtyFeet for this important work to help remove children from the facilities—all donations up to \$60,000 made through December 31, 2011 will be matched dollar for dollar.

In addition to the land purchase and construction project, we are also in the process of opening homes for the older children (10 and above) SixtyFeet serves. These homes will be run in collaboration with our ministry partner, Cornerstone Development, who specializes in ministering to teens and young adults. We hope to have our first home for boys up and running in Kampala by January. We covet your prayers for these exciting new areas of the ministry.

2012 Mission Trips

In September of 2011, SixtyFeet began opening our mission trips to any interested participants.

Now, through our partnership with Visiting Orphans, you can join us on the mission field in Uganda. Trips are currently planned for January, March, July and October of 2012. The July trip is a Father-Son trip. We're also planning a Mother-Daughter trip for April of 2013.

Traveling to Africa with SixtyFeet is not your average short-term missions experience. Our mission trips are not project oriented but people oriented. We seek to provide our mission teams with opportunities to learn about and experience the culture and the



mission field in which we serve. We desire for our trips to be relational in nature and consistent with the long-term mission work of SixtyFeet.
